Bone Patterns

“Humans turned bones into patterns to remember people. Can you spot the math, the art, and the feelings?”

Ask your kid(s) to quietly point out the patterns they find. And, to point out any animals they find.

When leaving, ask them how visiting this place made them feel - in one word. Then, consider asking what other objects they could use to create similar patterns and art (fruit, nuts, coins, legos, rocks, etc).

Stained Glass Window Stories

Mini-challenge: “Pick a window and tell the story you think it's showing—who's the hero, and what's the quest?” With multiple kids, they could take turns telling each other the stories they see. Record one or two as a keepsake.

When leaving, share that the church took 500 years to build! What would they add to the church today if it was their job to complete it?

Treasure and Money Mysteries

Point out: old mint rooms, royal audience halls, coins and dies (if on display).

Mini-challenge: “Design a coin: what picture goes on the Kutná Hora ‘kids’ ducat’ and why?”

Kid fact: Silver from these mines funded kings—this place was like the medieval “money factory.”

Statues with Superpowers

Point out: the statues guarding the path with the views

Mini-challenge: "Pick a statue and invent its superpower. What does it protect?"

Add On: Can you find something with circles, lines or animals?

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
